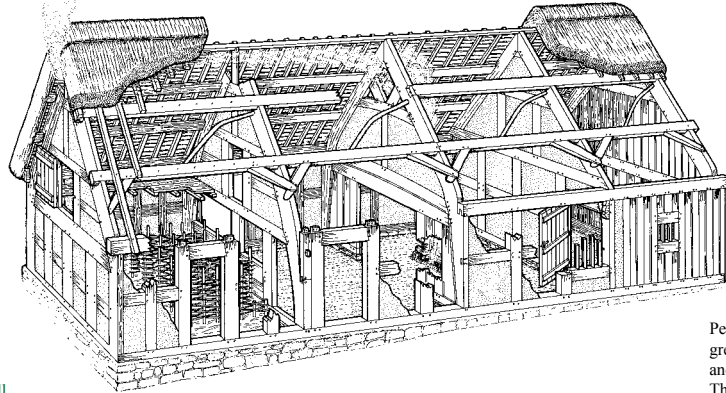


TAI NEUADD GWERINOL: 1500-1560

PEASANT HALL-HOUSES: 1500-1560



Fersiynau llai o'r tai neuadd mawr oedd y tai neuadd gwerinol. Nid oedd dau raniad i'r neuadd ac yn aml byddai beudy ynghlwm wrthi. Mae'r lluniad (uchod) yn dangos cynllun Tyddyn Llwydion (Pennant Melangell, Powys), a godwyd o goed a gwympwyd ym 1554. Mae Cwmyrychen (Sant Harmon) (gwaclod) yn dangos bod mynedfa'r neuadd weithiau wedi'i haddurno.

Peasant halls were scaled down versions of greater hall-houses with a hall of a single bay and often had a cowhouse in the lower-end bays. The cutaway drawing (top) shows the plan of Tyddyn Llwydion (Pennant Melangell, Powys) built from timber felled in 1554. Cwmyrychen (St Harmon) (bottom) shows that the entrance into the hall was sometimes provided with decoration.
