Rear of mill reduced by 0.5m - most of area made of ground comprising stones in ^{dark} grey silt. Section of ^{0.5m wide} ~~path~~ ^{prevented} extending serving pit by 2.1m to SW. ^{clearly reduced} when mill refurbished (1867?) Well did not reach SW wall of building - evidenced? Yellowish sandy lime mortar - wall is different. In mill house - cobbled floor beneath - actually more even than thought in soil (dairy). Photos taken for composite. In parlour - a further flagged floor identified below ^{+ passage} 0.1m of loose sand stone & thin clay (yellow) layer - photos for composite ^{over}

taken up over small area to c. 0.5m depth
revealing stone & gravel - could be natural or
imported levelling deposit. No finds.

At NW end of interior both floors terminated
before reaching the wall so perhaps these
